## God Will Provide

Throughout the troubles and sorrows that make up life, God will provide. One may not feel that He has always been by our side helping in one way or another during our times of need. But you can rest assured that you, as a child of God, will receive His strength and hope needed to resolve what seems at the time are insurmountable obstacles to any solution.

Philippians 4:4-7 Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice! Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand. Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Let your prayers be requests to the Lord. When you speak to our Father in heaven, you should not hide anything because He knows all and surpasses all understanding. Prayer becomes an opportunity to surrender all your worries to Him, being afforded the opportunity to lean on Him for all hope and guidance.

Any prayer directed to acquire excessive wealth or other grossly expensive "toys" solely centered on pleasing oneself would not be advised because it is not in accord with God's righteous attitude.

Matthew 6: 25-34 "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? "Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? "Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature? "So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; "and yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. "Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' "For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

In a walk with God, we will experience His blessing, but only if we truly honor Him. A lot of people in the world say they know God, proclaiming they are his children while concurrently practicing a multitude of diverse ways of worshiping Him. Yes, but what God truly demands is honoring Him with a credence of belief that effects a mindchanging life of obedience in accord with what God, as our all-knowing Creator-Protector commands us to do. Without so doing, we remain in a state of spiritual deficiency, falling far short of the loving obedience by us so desired by our Creator. This active doing of His word is what makes His children set apart from the rest of the world!!

Galatians 5:13-18 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another! I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

2 Corinthians 12:6-8 But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.
